Locking in Real Action on Climate Change

Steven Miles, in his first speech as Premier, committed the Labor Government to delivering a 75% reduction in emissions by 2035 - to keep global warming to below 2 degrees.

So far, Queensland has reduced emissions by 35% and by more than any other state.

Labor achieved this because we restored vegetation management laws to reduce tree clearing by over 50%, combined with our world leading Queensland Energy and Jobs Plan which is replacing coal with renewables.

If elected, the Miles Labor Government will continue to build the wind, solar, and long duration energy storage needed to cut emissions by 75% by 2035, and build a clean economy future.

- Peter Dutton says step one in his nuclear plan is to elect a Crisafulli LNP Government

Protecting Queensland's Environment

The Miles Labor Government has an outstanding record protecting Australia's most biodiverse state, with **over 15 million hectares now protected** - more than double the size of Tasmania. And we have delivered over 12 million hectares of Net Free Zones in the Great Barrier Reef, Sandy Straits and Gulf.

We are progressing a **World Heritage listing of key cultural and natural sites across Cape York Peninsula**, working with Traditional Owners to protect these pristine landscapes.

If elected, the Miles Labor Government will deliver the **54,000 hectare Greater Glider Forest Park** protecting old growth eastern hardwood forests and providing refuge to koalas and hollow dependent gliders, birds and bats.

A Miles Labor Government will deliver an Independent Environmental Protection Agency.

Our \$140 million will triple the size of Queensland's nature fund, with \$43.5 million to incentivise private protected areas and help more landholders to profit from conservation rather than clearing.
